

Sipet's house was so messy!




Whoa! There were thousands of

into a hole.


It was very
dark inside.


Sipet's walnuts

CRACK !


Sipet sat on something. It was Sipet's pine nuts. Ugh, Sipet must really clean his house.

Hurray!


Sipet got a special woodchip!



Designer
